Chamber Cancels Autumn Leaves Festival

The Greater Mount Airy Chamber of Commerce announced today that due to the Covid 19 Pandemic, the 2020 Autumn Leaves Festival has been cancelled. The Chamber Board of Directors met recently and made that decision at their July 21 meeting. The date for the 2020 event was scheduled for October 9, 10 & 11.

Chamber Chairman of the Board James Etringer added "Our main priority was looking after the health and safety of the attendees. After discussing several options, we felt it was best to cancel this year's event. It was a tough decision, since the festival means so much to the community, but we look forward to hosting the event next year. "

The Autumn Leaves Festival is the largest event in the region and in previous years has attracted over 200,000 attendees and 200 vendors during the three-day event. The festival is organized by the Greater Mount Airy Chamber of Commerce and has been held every year since 1966.

Chamber President and CEO Randy Collins reported that "The Chamber looks forward to the Autumn Leaves Festival returning in 2021, bigger and better than ever." The date for the 2021 Autumn Leaves Festival will be October 8, 9 and 10.
